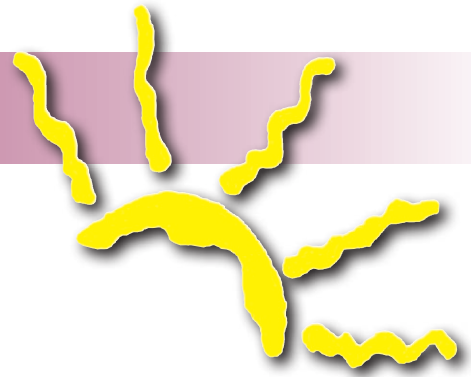


Frequently Asked Questions...



Q. *Where are you located?*

A. The Community Adult Day Care Center is located at 816 Pro Drive, Celina, Ohio. Our facility features a home-like atmosphere in a cozy, wooded setting.

Q. *Why would I want to use the Community Adult Day Care Center?*

A. Many family members are responsible for taking care of aging parents or family members who have disabilities. Community Adult Day Care Center provides needed periods of respite to families and caregivers, enabling them to continue/resume employment and tend to the necessary activities of their lives. Other clients who live on their own enjoy coming to the Community Adult Day Care Center because of the socialization with others, activities and being part of "our" family.

Q. *What hours are you open and are you open on holidays?*

A. Our facility is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. We are closed on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Independence Day, Christmas Day, Labor Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Eve (open half day).

Q. *Does my loved one have to come every day?*

A. No. They are able to come daily if they choose, but they can also come one day a week, two days a week or just on an as needed basis. We are very flexible! We have clients that stay for a whole day and those that choose to come for a few hours before returning to their own home.

Q. *How many clients do you have at the Community Adult Day Care Center?*

A. The number varies from day to day, but can range from five to ten clients at the present time.

Q. *Are there more men than women who attend or visa versa?*

A. Again, this varies from day to day, but on an average, the ratio is equal men to women.

Q. *How do I get my loved one to and from the facility?*

A. Transportation to and/or from Community Adult Day Care Center can be done by a family member or we can provide this service for a small fee. Call our office at 419-586-1999 or 419-586-6634 for details.

Q. *How far will you go to pick up a visitor to your center?*

A. We travel all of Mercer County and surrounding areas including most of Auglaize and northern Darke Counties.

Q. *Do most of your clients have Dementia?*

A. Some of our clients have different levels of Dementia, but we also have several that come for the day without any type of Dementia. They attend for the socialization and activities.

Q. *What does your Center look like?*

A. Community Adult Day Care Center is located in a wooded setting which allows our clients to enjoy nature from our safely gated, open-air patio. The interior has a bright, cheery atmosphere with wide open spaces making it easy for our clients to move around safely.

Q. *How many people do you have on staff?*

A. We have an Activities Director, Personal Care Aide, Van Driver, Licensed Registered Nurse and several volunteers. Clients at the Community Adult Day Care Center receive specialized care during their entire stay at the Center.

Q. *What kind of services will my loved one receive while at Community Adult Day Care Center?*

A. This depends on the client, but includes: personal hygiene, a variety of activities, rehabilitation therapy as ordered by a physician, massage therapy, hair care, meals and snacks.

Q. *What kind of activities do you have for your clients?*

A. There are always three to four different activities planned for each day. These can include: crafts, music, games, age-appropriate trivia, range-of-motion exercises, outings, singing and our famous Cooking Club. We pride ourselves in keeping our clients active within their own limits.

Q. *Can I cancel a visit?*

A. We ask that you notify us as soon as possible when you have to cancel. You may leave a message on our answering machine any time of day or night. Listen to local radio stations for cancellations due to inclement weather.

Q. *Will my loved one receive their daily medications at the Community Adult Day Care Center?*

A. Yes. You are to bring the prescription medications in the original pharmacy container for our nurse to administer. For over-the-counter medicines, if taken routinely, we ask that you bring a new bottle. Otherwise, if needed occasionally, we stock basic system control medicines in a secured area.

Q. *Is there a place for my loved one to keep their personal effects?*

A. Yes. All clients are assigned a locker where their coat, sweater, hat, etc., can be stored. We ask that you label the clothing with the client's name.

Q. *How much does a visit to the Community Adult Day Care Center cost?*
