Rays of Hope Camp

Aug. 17-19, 2010

Rays of Hope is a 3-day camp for children and youths who have experienced the death of a loved one. It provides an opportunity for children to meet with others in age-appropriate groups, helping them to understand their grief.

The camp experience is intended to provide opportunities for friendships, counseling, and learning about the normalcy of grief. It is NOT intended to be grief therapy.

Rays of Hope is presented by Community Health Professionals' Hospice of Defiance and Williams and Fulton Counties. The camp is held at the Defiance UAW Hall, 2120 Baltimore Rd.

Rays of Hope is divided into three groups by age: Ages 6-9, Ages 9-11, and Ages 12-17.

Each group is assigned a hospice social worker to lead the group's activities and discussions.

Pre-registration is required. Cost is just \$20 for one family member, \$25 for two and \$30 for three or more. *No one is denied due to financial need.*

At **Rays of Hope** kids learn:

- * Through activities
- * About grief
- * To support each other and most importantly,
- * **They are not alone!**
